Pastor Fremio had been somewhat restricted in ministry efforts in recent months, not too long ago he had a motorcycle accident. Pastor Fremio is recovering well and doing much better. He is now up and walking, out and about. We praise God for his full recovery. Ministry in El Mango Limpio is going well. Services have resumed and people are coming together for worship. There was a recent fire in the El Mango Limpio Village close to where one of the first members of the church resides. We are grateful that no one was hurt though the entire residence was destroyed. The Pastors want to be able to help this family however they can and members of the congregation are doing what they can to help them also. Please pray for their family that lost everything and have to go through this process of recovery. Kilometer 20 outreach work is going great. The last they were able to do is purchase land with the help of Higher Hope Church and now they have built a temporary roofing structure to help keep them out of the rain.





Estimations are under way for them to build up a house of worship and we are excited to see this happen in a place that has been so difficult to church plant in. Kilometer 20 is so alive with children and families that live there. We have had events where 100s of children show up and participate. There was another church there but has since been closed and no efforts are underway with the exception of the Dominican Conference there now. We are making a way to something better! Pastor Brigida from the City Church La Grey de Dios is having some health issues. They plan to operate on her this year and she is concerned. She currently serves as the Conference Treasurer. We have prayed with her by phone and we are asking all of you to keep her in prayer also. It has been some time since we have had a mission teams to the Dominican Republic and we left one mission outreach incomplete in their efforts to finish their church building. They have as a community tried to do some things to finish it up but there is more to be done.
